Additionally, we are launching a new internship project focused on preparing Tarboro High School students for college (tutoring, researching scholarships, essay assistance, etc).

If you are passionate about educational equity and want to learn more about making it a reality in rural communities, this is the internship for you! This summer's work is especially critical as the school system will be returning to full-time in-person instruction for fall 2022.
