Arts in the Schools

- Work with the Executive Director and Board of Directors programming committee to develop meaningful art-based programs that connect students of all backgrounds through the Arts.
- Work with teachers, administrators and instructors for programming coordination and scheduling.
- Work with other community organizations (The GRAMMY Museum Mississippi, Bologna Performing Arts Center, Delta State University Art Dept., etc.) and partners to develop creative programming that aligns with our Mission.
- Development and maintenance of the master programming calendars.
- Creative e-mailers, social media posts and communication to community members and schools on upcoming art programs and events.
- Sharing our Mission of making art accessible to all peoples, and encouraging art as a prominent part of daily life.
- Visiting students and schools to actively participate in programming, student engagement and arts awareness.
- Working with the Delta Arts Alliance board of directors to share development ideas and programming observations/feedback related to Arts in the Schools.
- Grant procurement for funding community Arts programs. (Scholars are not required to participate in the grant writing process, but we will share the overall process as this is a large part of maintaining a non-profit organization).

Arts in the World

- Work with the Executive Director and Board of Directors programming committee to develop meaningful art-based programming that connects peoples of all backgrounds, cultures and ages through the Arts.
- Work with other community organizations (The GRAMMY Museum Mississippi, Bologna Performing Arts Center, Delta State University Arts, etc.) to develop community events that do not overlap with other scheduled public programming.
- Development and maintain the master community events calendars.
- Creative e-mailers, social media posts and communication to community members on upcoming art events.
- Sharing our Mission of making art accessible to all peoples, and encouraging art as a prominent part of daily life.
- Working with the Delta Arts Alliance board of directors to share development ideas and observations/feedback related to Arts in the World.
- Grant procurement for funding community Art events. (Scholars are not required to participate in the grant writing process, but we will share the overall process as this is a large part of maintaining a non-profit organization).
- Working closely with the Executive Director and Programming Committee to develop and execute monthly art gallery exhibitions.
- Working with Mississippi based Artists to schedule gallery openings and exhibitions that are free to the public.
- Creative research to find new artist contributors to present and show work (fine artists, authors, poets, filmmakers, photographers, musician performances, etc.).
